I would like to take this opportunity to express our opinion on the Zinga product. The Province of British Columbia Ferry Corporation built some new ramps to load vehicle onto their ferries and used Zinga on their new ramps and have had no reaction to salt water and rust to their ramps. We have used this product since 1997 and built many things and sprayed Zinga to cover welds and completed projects and used it as an under coat .

Since we have a welding shop and fabrication area we have the opportunity to try Zinga with very good success.

In 1997 we built a gantry to lift and install our salt spreader onto our vehicles during the winter storms, this gantry was undercoated with Zinga and then painted. From April 1997 till now the paint is the original paint and still shows no signs of peeling or blistering.

Welding fences, railings, salt and sand spreaders, Zinga itself on galvanized metal blends in very well as the colour is slightly off from the original metal and would not have to be repainted and could be left alone.

I have no problems making a recommendation, and being a reference for the Zinga products as we have been very please how it has worked for our operation.
