

CANOPY – TIANJIN MUSEUM – CHINA

The **Tianjin Museum** is the largest museum in Tianjin, China, exhibiting a range of cultural and historical relics significant to Tianjin. The museum lies in Yinhe Plaza in the Hexi District of Tianjin and covers an area of about 50.000m². The unique architectural style of the museum, whose appearance resembles that of a swan spreading its wings, has meant that it is quickly becoming one of the city's iconic buildings.

The **Tianjin Museum** has an extensive collection of ancient Chinese fine arts and exhibits on Tianjin's history.



In front of the Museum is a 10.000 m² wide Swan Lake.

It is the canopy that goes across this beautiful lake that has been protected against corrosion using **ZINGA** during the construction of the museum that was finished in 2006.
