

GRATINGS - EXXONMOBIL PLATFORM YOHO – MALAYSIA

Some pictures of 2007 touch up work with **ZINGA** taken on an offshore platform at **Sime Semcorp Engineering Shipyard** in Johor Bahru, Malaysia.

This project concerns the **YOHO ExxonMobil platform**, for Nigeria. The YOHO field lies in Oil Mining Lease (OML) 104, offshore Nigeria. The completed project will cost approximately USD 1.2 billion and will recover an estimated 0.4 billion barrels of crude oil from the YOHO and AWAWA reservoirs.

These reservoirs lie in a water depth of between 200 ft and 300 ft.

The gratings on the rig were formatted for this platform. The burned or welded pieces of gratings had to be HDG treated again. But in order not to remove them, transport, bring back and mount again after HDG treatment **ExxonMobil** were looking for an alternative with a film galvanizing system. **They choose ZINGA to touch up HDG areas and to completely Zingalize some.**
