

AIRCO – DON MUANG AIRPORT BANGKOK – THAILAND

Don Muang International Airport is one of the two international airports serving Bangkok, the other one being Suvarnabhumi Airport. Commercial flights began in 1924.

Don Muang Airport closed in 2006 following the opening of Bangkok's new Suvarnabhumi Airport, before opening again after renovation on 24 March 2007.

At the beginning of 2008, the airconditioning system at the **Don Muang Airport** in Bangkok was regalanised using **ZINGA**.

For aesthetical reasons, the **ZINGA** was overcoated with a sealer, **ZINGALUFER**, and a local topcoat.



System:

Surface preparation:

Wet blasting ST3 (mecanically)

ZINGA 1 x 80 µm DFT

(brush & roller)

ZINGALUFER 1 x 40µm DFT

Local topcoat 2 x 40µm DFT
