

PHUTTA YODFA BRIDGE - THAILAND

The **Memorial Bridge** is a bridge over the Chao Phraya River in Bangkok, in Thailand, connecting the districts Phra Nakhon and Thonburi.

Construction of the bridge started on 3 December 1929, in Middlesbrough, England.

The total length of the bridge is 678 meter.

In the middle of 2011, the bridge was re-galvanized using **ZINGA**.

For aesthetical reasons, the **ZINGA** was overcoated with a local topcoat.
